Today:

The San Jose Barracuda and the Bakersfield Condors (AHL affiliate of the Edmonton Oilers) meet for the 7th of 12 meetings this season, the 4th of six meetings at the SAP Center. The Barracuda are 3-2-0-1 vs. the Condors this season and are 3-2-0-1 in six career matchups. San Jose is 2-0-0-0 on their three game home stand and currently sits in 3rd place in the Pacific Division. The Condors have won a season high four straight games and are just percentage points behind the Barracuda in the standings for the final guaranteed playoff spot in the Pacific Division. **Ryan Carpenter** has 10 points (2-8-10) in six games vs. the Condors while **Matthew Ford** has eight points (7-1-8) in six games vs. the Barracuda.

In case you missed it...

Aaron Dell made 30 saves as the San Jose Barracuda (21-16-5-3, 50pts) presented by Barracuda Networks picked up an impressive 5-0 victory over the visiting San Antonio Rampage (22-22-7-0, 51pts) on Pink in the Rink Day presented by Kaiser Permanente in front of 4,696 fans at SAP Center on Saturday afternoon. **Ben Smith** scored twice while **Patrick McNally**, **Nikita Jevpalovs**, and **Bryan Lerg** also struck for San Jose as goaltender **Aaron Dell** made 30 saves in net for the franchise's 1st shutout. **Trevor Parkes** added two assists as the Barracuda improved to 2-0-0-0 on their three game home stand which ends on Sunday at 3pm vs. the Bakersfield Condors.

JJ Khaira, **Anton Slepyshev**, and **Rob Klinkhammer** scored while **Anders Nilsson** made 37 saves in net in his Condors' debut as Bakersfield won their season high 4th straight game with a 3-2 victory in Ontario on Friday night. **Andrew Miller** added two assists as Bakersfield won despite getting outshot 39-17.

*Now in his 18th season as the San Jose Sharks AHL affiliate's head coach, **Roy Sommer** ranks 1st in the AHL in games coached (1,389) and now victories (638) as he surpassed Fred Cook with the 4-2 victory over the Ontario Reign (AHL affiliate of the LA Kings) on Feb 10. In the AHL, he has coached 120 players who have gone on to play in the NHL, including 95 who have spent a portion of their careers with the San Jose Sharks. In all, 20 players who have dressed for the San Jose Sharks this season played for Sommer in the AHL at one point in their career.

***Bryan Lerg**, **Mirco Mueller**, **Dylan DeMelo**, **Nikolay Goldobin**, **Melker Karlsson**, **Micheal Haley**, **John McCarthy**, **Barclay Goodrow**, **Ryan Carpenter**, **Ben Smith**, **Matt Tennyson**, **Chris Tierney**, and **Alex Stalock** have all played for the Barracuda (AHL) and the Sharks (NHL) this season.

*Breaking down February.... The Barracuda have a 2-2-0-0 (4pts in 4gp) record in February with 11 GF and 6 GA. PP is 4-13 (30.8%); opponent's power play is 1-12 (8.3%); and the Barracuda have 0 fighting majors in February.
