Today:

The San Jose Barracuda and the Stockton Heat (AHL affiliate of the Calgary Flames) meet for the 12th of 12 meetings this season, the 6th of six meetings at the SAP Center. The Barracuda are 8-1-1-1 vs. the Heat this season and 5-0-0-0 vs. the Heat at SAP Center. San Jose returns home after a six game road trip (1-4-1-0) and will play their last regular season game today needing just one point (force overtime or win) to clinch the final playoff spot in the Pacific Division. If the Barracuda pick up a point today, they would face the LA Kings AHL affiliate (Ontario Reign) in the Pacific Division Semifinals. The Heat have been eliminated from the playoff picture and look to play the role of the spoiler today. The Barracuda have outscored the Heat 50-30 this season. Matt Tennyson is currently with the Barracuda on a conditioning assignment from the SJ Sharks.

In case you missed it...

The San Jose Barracuda (30-26-8-3, 71pts) presented by Barracuda Networks failed to clinch the final playoff spot in the Western Conference after a 5-4 regulation loss to the host Stockton Heat (32-31-2-2, 68pts) in front 8,041 fans at Stockton Arena on Saturday evening. Trevor Parkes (2-0-2), Nikolay Goldobin (1-1-2), and Joakim Ryan (0-2-2) all had multi point games for San Jose while Aaron Dell made 23 saves in net in the loss. Nikita Jevpalovs also scored for the Barracuda in a wild game that saw San Jose trail 3-1, lead 4-3, but lose 5-4 in regulation. Kenny Agostino recorded four points (2-2-4) for the Heat as Stockton defeated the Barracuda for the first time this season in regulation. Rookie netminder Nick Schneider made 33 saves in net for Stockton while Hunter Shinkaruk scored the game winner and added an assist for the Heat in their final home game of the season.
