Eagle Scout: The San Jose Barracuda and Colorado Eagles (Avalanche) close out their two-game set on Saturday night at Tech CU Arena after the Avs affiliate picked up a 5-2 win on Friday. Saturday will be the final of two games on the year between the clubs in the Bay Area. The Barracuda are set to travel to Loveland, Colorado, on Jan. 20 and 21 to wrap up the four-game season series. A year ago, the Barracuda went 1-6-1-0 against the Eagles and 1-2-1-0 at home. All time the Barracuda are 12-15-4-1 against Colorado and 7-7-2-0 in the Bay Area. Dating back to last season, the Barracuda have now dropped eight in a row to Eagles (0-7-1-0), getting outscored 33-13 during that stretch.

Friday Funk: The Barracuda fell behind early on Friday against Colorado and could never recover, losing 5-2 in the first meeting of the four-game season series. Justin Bailey and Ozzy Wiesblatt managed to score San Jose's only two goals in the loss, while Ben Meyers notched his first AHL hat-trick and Riley Tufte collected a career-high three helpers as he assisted on each Meyers' tally. Oskar Olausson also scored for Colorado on the power play, and Keaton Middleton sealed the win with Colorado's second of two empty-netters. Justus Annunen made 26 saves and has now won four in a row against the Barracuda dating back to last season. After Friday, the Barracuda are now 0-6 in the first game of a two-game series this year, getting outscored in those games 31-10.

Eagle Expectations: The Eagles reached the postseason for the fifth consecutive year in 2022-23 as now Anaheim Ducks head coach Greg Cronin led the group to 40-22-7-3 mark which was good for 3rd in the Pacific Division. Colorado's top two scorers from last season, Charles Hudon (Ontario Reign) and Alex Galchenyuk (St. Petersburg SKA), are no longer with the team, but 13 players are back from the 2022-23 squad. The Eagles are 2-5-2-0 on the road this season and have begun their current four-game roadie with a 2-1 record after starting the year 0-4-2-0 on the road through its first six. Of Colorado's nine games on visiting ice this season, they've scored the first goal just three times. The Eagles will begin a sixgame homestand next Friday against the Texas Stars. The Avs farm team boasts the league's fifth-best penalty kill (41/46=87.2%) but rank 17th (25/30=85%) on the road in PK percentage.

Gush Goin': The Sharks assigned forward Danil Gushchin back to the AHL on Friday morning after collecting one assist in two games up top. The sophomore forward is pacing the Barracuda in points (13), points-per-game (1.18), shots (49), Tfirst in assists (9), and T-second in goals (4). A year ago, as a rookie, he ranked first among league freshmen in shots (203), T-11th in goals (22), T-13th in points (45), T-10th in power-play goals (7), and 16th in shootout percentage (4/7=57.1%).

Tuf Customer: Former Dallas Stars first-rounder Riley Tufte is off to a hot start in his first season with the Avs organization. The six-foot-six, 230-pounder collected three assists on Friday and now has a point in 10 of his first 11 games (9+7=16) in an Eagles' sweater. Tufte, a two-time National Champion at Minnesota-Duluth, ranks T-third in the AHL in shots (51) and goals, T-sixth in points, and T-first in points-per-game (1.45) among skaters who have appeared in at least five games this season. In addition, he has skated in three games up top with the Avalanche. A year ago, he set career-highs in goals (19), assists (16), points (35), penalty minutes (90), and plus/minus (+23) as a member of the Texas Stars.

**AIR vs. SEA –** Colorado will take on the San Jose Barracuda tonight for the second time in the season series, after picking up a 5-2 win last night. The Eagles were a near-perfect 7-0-1 against the Barracuda during the 2022-23 campaign, including a mark of 3-0-1 in games played at Tech CU Arena. Forward Cal Burke leads all returning Colorado skaters, having posted seven points in eight games against San Jose last season, while fellow forward Cedric Pare notched three goals in six meetings with the Barracuda. Goaltender Justus Annunen went 3-0-1 against San Jose last year, complimented by a 1.75 goals-against average, .942 save-percentage and one shutout.

STREAKING BY- Eagles captain Brad Hunt picked up an assist in last Sunday's loss at Ontario and now has points in six of his last seven games. The 35-year-old has now notched four goals and six assists in his last 10 games. Meanwhile, forward D.J. Busdeker comes into tonight's game having generated points in five of his first seven games as an Eagle. In addition, forward Oskar Olausson scored a power-play goal last night and has now posted points in five of his last six games, registering five goals and one assist in that span.

**POINT PRODUCERS**- Forward Riley Tufte registered a season-high three assists last night and now leads the team in both goals (9) and points (16) and is tied for the team lead with seven assists. Tufte has notched points in 10 of his first 11 games of the season. Meanwhile, forward Ben Meyers is fresh off his first career hat trick and has generated four goals and one assist in his last two contests. After failing to produce a hat trick during the 2022-23 season, the Eagles have already collected two hat tricks in the first 15 games of the 2023-24 season, with both Tufte and Meyers posting three-goal performances in the last two weeks.

**EARLY START-** A solid first period has proven to be a major advantage for the Eagles this season, as Colorado sports a record of 4-0-0 when taking a lead into the first intermission and is 6-1-0 when scoring the game's first goal. The Eagles have ridden early success to victories, as the team is 6-1-1 when leading after two periods of play. Colorado checked all three boxes in last night's 5-2 win, as the Eagles scored the first two goals of the game and carried a lead into both the first and second intermission.

**FRESH AMMO** – After scoring the game-winning goal at San Diego last Saturday, defenseman Wyatt Aamodt now has three goals through his first 10 games of the season, already matching the three goals he produced across 52 games last year as a rookie. The 25-year-old has netted his three goals this year on just 13 shots, placing him 8<sup>th</sup> among all AHL defensemen with a shooting percentage of 23%.

Konowachuk, 50, is returning to the Avalanche organization where he not only finished his playing career but also started his coaching career. The Salt Lake City, Utah, native spent the final two seasons of his NHL playing career with Colorado in 2003-04 and 2005-06 before retiring at the start of the 2006 training camp due to a heart condition. Following one year in the Avalanche's player development department (2007-08), Konowalchuk began his coaching career as an assistant with the Avalanche in 2009-10, helping Colorado to a 26-point turnaround and a spot in the 2010 Stanley Cup Playoffs. He spent one more season as the Avalanche's assistant coach in 2010-11 before joining the Seattle Thunderbirds of the Western Hockey League as their head coach in 2011-12.

Konowalchuk spent six seasons as Seattle's head coach (2011-17), leading the club to five playoff berths and the 2016-17 Ed Chynoweth Cup as WHL champions. After a one-year stint as an assistant coach with the Anaheim Ducks in 2017-18, Konowalchuk joined the New York Rangers organization and worked as both an amateur and professional scout from 2018-21. He then returned to the WHL ranks, spending the past two seasons as head coach of the Red Deer Rebels (2021-23).

The Eagle River, Wisconsin native guided the Grizzlies to a record of 284-205-76 and six playoff appearances during his time in West Valley City.

Prior to earning his first head coaching position, Branham spent three seasons as an assistant coach with the ECHL's Reading Royals from 2010-2013. During his time with the Royals, the team went 143-89-23 in the regular season and captured the 2013 Kelly Cup title.

Branham was drafted in the third round of the 2000 NHL Entry Draft by the Vancouver Canucks and played 284 professional games in the ECHL and AHL during his playing career as a defenseman from 2002-2010.

#### Career Notes:

Schneekloth is in his first season as a head coach in the AHL after spending the last 10 years on the Eagles' coaching staff, which included a pair of championship seasons as the team's head coach while the Eagles were Colorado's ECHL affiliate. He led the Eagles to back-to-back Kelly Cup titles in 2016-17 and 2017-18, posting a 95-38-11 (.698) combined regular-season record followed by a 32-12 playoff mark. The Calgary, Alberta, native finished runner-up for ECHL Coach of the Year in both campaigns.

Including his final seven years as a player, the upcoming 2023-24 campaign will mark Schneekloth's 18th consecutive season with the Eagles organization.

Schneekloth, 45, has served as the Eagles' assistant coach for the past five seasons since 2018-19. He began his coaching career with the ECHL Eagles in 2013-14 and spent three years in that role before taking over the head coaching position in 2016-17.

A former defenseman, Schneekloth played 11 seasons professionally, including the last seven in an Eagles sweater, helping the team win a CHL championship in 2007. He was named the ECHL's Defenseman of the year in 2012, while being voted the CHL's Most Outstanding Defenseman in both 2009 and 2010. A four-time All-Star and a member of both the CHL's All-Decade Team and the Colorado Eagles All-Decade Team, Schneekloth was also named to the All-ECHL Team in 2012 and was voted to the All-CHL Team on three separate occasions (2008-2010).

Schneekloth retired in 2013 as the Eagles' all-time leader in points (356), goals (111) and assists (245) by a defenseman. He won an NCAA championship with the University of North Dakota in 2000.

Aaron and his wife, Kristie, have two children, son Gabe and daughter Bree.
